The Church

Unfortunately services in the church have been suspended during the current crisis, and the church is locked according to government instructions. Many services are available to those who have access online and the BBC will be broadcasting worship. Weddings and baptisms are postponed. The situation on funerals is that they are (at the time of writing) permitted in Crematoria and at the graveside with a minimum number only in attendance - spouse and sons & daughters. This situation may change. The Rector is aware of the deep sadness that this situation creates for those who are grieving and memorial services will be offered when a normal situation resumes.
