#### PUBLIC FORUM

- An update was given on the future of Stogursey Motors
- A resident queried why the precept was not being applied across all bandings, as the recent Stogursey News update said it only applied to "B and D". The Chairman said that the precept applies to all bandings and that the Clerk would provide the actual figures for all bandings to them as soon as possible.

#### 23/145 MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETINGS held on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2024:

The draft minutes of the last parish council meeting had been circulated. The Clerk also circulated amendments to the Financial statements relating to September, October, November and December, which had an error on the payments and receipts, but the overall balances were correct. They were proposed as amended by Cllr J Jones seconded by Cllr A Searle and were unanimously **AGREED** for signature by the V/Chairman as a true and accurate record of the meetings.

No further declarations of Interest and / or dispensations in addition to those already declared and available for public inspection, were made.

### 23/147 PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

The meeting noted that no applicant had come forward.

### 23/148 UPDATE FROM SOMERSET COUNCILLORS

Cllr Woods and Cllr Davies had submitted written updates which had been previously circulated to the members were noted. Cllr Davies highlighted the concerns over the Asian hornet, continued diversion of the Community Bus, ongoing budget issues for Somerset Council.

### 23/149 LONG TERM ACTION LIST

No updates on items.

### 23/150 HINKLEY POINT POWER STATION

The Vice Chairman reported that at the Site Stakeholders Group the NDA were highlighting a telephone consultation being done nationwide on a cross section of the population by postcode regarding long term decommissioning issues, with local consultations to take place in coming years. The site director highlighted improving relationships between workers and management following a cultural change, improving productivity. B Station director was leaving and C Site are supplying a replacement. B station defueling of Reactor 4 should be complete by May 2024 and Reactor 3 by 2025. Andrew Cockcroft will update the Parish Council meeting in March on current topics. The workforce uplift may be as high as 15,000 overall, obvious impact on bus movements, accommodation as well as services on site.

### 23/151 FINANCE

- a) The list of invoices for payment and monies received in November, (Appendix 1) and the Financial Statement (Appendix 2) had been forwarded to members before the meeting and are attached to these minutes. The Financial Statement was noted. It was **resolved** unanimously that the Invoices for payment were to be settled. All payments will all be made online, direct debit or by debit card. **ACTION: Clerk**
- b) The meeting noted the budget monitoring statement o the end of the third quarter.

### 23/152 MEETING REPORTS

a) Town and Parish Clerks bi-weekly meeting. The Clerk gave a verbal update on the last meeting which focussed on the budget issue for Somerset Council ahead of the 20<sup>th</sup> February meeting which will resolve their way forward.

b) The Vice Chairman updated on the last LCN meeting at Nether Stowey, where yet again there was a lengthy discussion on the Highways Steward. There is also a proposal to form a highways sub group to liaise directly with Highways on probably a quarterly basis, reporting back to the main LCN, which was agreed.

- a) The meeting discussed the issues in the Hinkley Point C DCO Amendment Consultation (closes 29.2.24) and resolved unanimously to delegate the writing of the response to the Vice Chairman and the Clerk.
- b) The meeting discussed at length correspondence regarding the dates of future parish council meetings. The meeting resolved unanimously to remain on the second Tuesday of each month.

### 23/155 ENHANCEMENTS

a) Cllr Ford asked if the volunteers who look after the planters could be supported with the purchase of plants as required for the new season. The clerk advised that the financial regulations allowed for small purchases to be resolved by the Clerk/Chairman in between meetings if required.

### 23/156 HIGHWAYS ISSUES

The meeting heard that flooding issues were still causing concerns for those trying to travel around the parish roads due to further winter storms and field run off. The Clerk had reported the gullies on Castle Street for clearance following repeated flooding and had reported issues at Colepool for surfacing. National Grid has recommenced works locally in Stolford with site access points.

a) The meeting considered issues regarding Remembrance Day road closures in Stogursey and the Clerk had circulated advice/guidance from the local Constabulary and Somerset Council on event management, which highlighted risk assessment and road closure procedures, involving qualified marshals as well as signage. The Clerk was asked to seek information from the Council's insurers on the issues that would arise from individuals not following the guidance. Action: Clerk

### 23/157 PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

The Clerk reported a closure affecting WL23/21 at Newnham Bridge, following issues with a footbridge. Somerset Council budget issues may affect their ability to keep the PROW network available for use as they reduce cutting and maintenance.
