36. Flower Arrangement – A decorated piece of footwear, with a title. An exhibit of flowers and foliage, accessories can be used. Space allowed - 2 feet wide, 2 feet deep, height unlimited.
37. An exhibit of flowers & foliage on the theme of "My Favourite Book". Book title to be given. Space allowed - 2 feet wide, 2 feet deep, height unlimited.
38. A seasonal bouquet (hand-tied). Container/vase max diameter 6 inches.

STOGURSEY FLOWER SHOW RULES

All exhibits to be grown by or be the work of the exhibitor.

Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit in each class.

Classes A - E are for competitors of all ages;
Class F is only for children who must be under-12 on the day of the show.

ENTRY FORMS must be submitted by 5pm on **Thursday 29 August:**

Paper forms to be submitted, together with Entry Fee, to 12 St Andrew's Road, Stogursey; or sent by email to elenorkate@gmail.com, and the Entry Fee to be paid when exhibits are taken to the Victory Hall.

Any entries after this date cannot be included.

EXHIBITS are to be brought to the Victory Hall either:
Friday 30 August between 6pm - 8pm or
Saturday 31 August between 8.00am - 9.45am.

All exhibits must be in place in the Victory Hall by **9.45am on Saturday 31 August.**
The doors will close at 10.00am for judging, and the doors will not open again until 2.00pm.

Exhibitors will not be allowed to enter the hall from 9.45am - 2.00pm.

Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining a card from the Show Secretary and placing it under their exhibit. Exhibits without a card cannot be judged.

All exhibits to remain in place until after prize giving, then it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to remove them on the day by 5pm otherwise they will be disposed of as necessary.

Exhibitors to provide their own vases, containers, plates.

The Judges may withhold prizes if there are insufficient entries or those submitted are unworthy of a prize.

All exhibits are at the exhibitors' own risk, and although all care will be taken, the Committee cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage.

The Judges' decisions are final and binding.

Points to be awarded:

- 1st place: 3 points,
- 2nd place: 2 points,
- 3rd place: 1 point

Please make sure you have correct number of items in your exhibit and it is the correct size otherwise it will not be accepted.
